Scholarship Program

This scholarship is to honour the scholastic achievements and community commitment of students motivated to pursue higher education. The purpose of the scholarship is to support students pursuing post-secondary education with tuition fees and other associated costs such as books, meals, travel, and accommodation. Careful consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need and the student's community service record.

Amount

*Each qualified winner will receive a **one-time** scholarship award of **\$1000.00**. The scholarship is not renewable. Previous scholarship recipients cannot re-apply*

Deadline

*Complete application, on or before **October 1st, 2017**. Late applications will NOT be accepted for review or consideration; no exceptions. Applications may be obtained from the Church of Pentecost Toronto Head office at 2256 Shepherd Avenue West, Toronto, Ontario, M9M 1L7.*

Eligibility Requirements

To be a qualified applicant for a scholarship, a student must meet the following criteria at the time of submitting their application:

- Member of Church of Pentecost (PIWC North York) with regular attendance to church.*
- The applicant must be enrolled in college/University.*
- Participate in school and/or community/church activities.*
- Demonstrate leadership qualities.*
- Character traits of a constructive attitude, the ability to relate well to others and high moral.*
- Demonstrate need of financial assistance to further educational plans.*

Rules and Regulations

By submitting an Application for a scholarship, the applicant is agreeing to be bound by these Rules and Regulations. All applications are subject to the below Rules and Regulations:

- Students must be accepted/registered at a college or university in Canada for fall 2017/2018 term and provide proof of enrolment.*
- In order to qualify for the scholarship, students must send a completed application form with supporting documentation of financial need (i.e. OSAP application, textbook invoice etc.) by the application deadline*

of **October 1, 2017**. Upon submission, all applications become the property of the scholarship committee and will not be returned to the applicant

- Prior to submission, each applicant must sign his/her application unconditionally agreeing to be bound by these Rules and Regulations. Only persons who meet all of the applicable eligibility criteria provided are eligible to submit an application to this Scholarship Program. Unsigned applications will be considered incomplete and will not be accepted.

How to Apply

- Complete scholarship application form in its entirety.
- Personal, typed essay, 350 words maximum, double spaced, detailing **why the applicant selected the program field they are enrolled in and why they should be awarded the scholarship?**
- School transcript(s).
- Each applicant may submit only one application. All information required in a completed application must be sent in a single package. Incomplete Applications will not be accepted.

The scholarship committee reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, the right to disqualify any application it deems to be plagiarized, inappropriate, or offensive.

The Scholarship Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, without advance notice, modify, terminate or suspend the application, review or award process, in whole or in part.
